Dear Scholarship Applicant

**Re: Huntingtower Part-Scholarships for Years 7, 9 and 10 entry in 2021**

Thank you for your expression of interest in a Huntingtower Scholarship.

The **Academic Scholarship Examination** will be held on **Saturday 15 February (2020)** commencing at 9.00am.

Please arrive **no later than 8.30am**. It will conclude at approximately 12 noon.

Please refer to our website for what to bring on the day, **including some form of identification**.

**All** scholarship applicants (including General Excellence and Music) must also sit this Academic Examination.

**Music Scholarships** in orchestral instruments or piano are also available for entry to Years 7, 9 and 10.

Piano auditionees must have achieved at least AMEB Grade 5 level or equivalent.

Music auditions will be held the day after the academic exam.

Audition times will be emailed to applicants in February (after applications have closed).

Please see the special requirements for music auditions on our website.

The ACER Scholarship testing exam will be one measure in the decision regarding awarding of Scholarships.

Other measures will include providing the following information, along with the Huntingtower Application form:-

*School report (2019 full end of year report), Naplan test results (most recent), Certificates of achievement, Sporting ability/achievements, Music ability/achievements, Leadership achievements and Community Service.*

**All** scholarship applicants (including current Huntingtower students) must include this information with their application, including levels attained. If you would like to include a reference from a teacher, principal, sporting organisation, church group, community service organisation, etc. (this is not essential), please feel free to do so.

Current Huntingtower students are not required to provide written references from their teachers.

There are **TWO** steps applicants must complete to register.

You **MUST** complete **BOTH** of these steps to be officially registered:-

**1. ONLINE REGISTRATION FORM**

Please complete the **online registration form** by visiting our website [www.huntingtower.vic.edu.au](http://www.huntingtower.vic.edu.au) and selecting "Enrolments" then "Scholarships".

Once you have completed this online registration you will be given a Candidate ID number.

***It is important to note that schools do not share scholarship results with one another.***

***Candidates must sit the Academic exam at Huntingtower on the set date to be eligible.***

**2. HUNTINGTOWER APPLICATION FORM**

This Application form and supporting documentation must be sent to the school once you have received your 2019 end of year school report. If this documentation is not provided by the closing date (February 5th) we will not be able to accept your application. Please send this documentation to:-

The **closing date** for applications is Wednesday 5 February 2020 (**no late applications can be accepted**).
