COVID Safe Venues

We have developed our COVID Safe Plan to maximise the safety of everyone that enters our venue. The pandemic has required us to revisit how we operate to ensure a safe and comfortable environment for everyone.

Safety First

We are committed to maximising the safety of our venues and workplaces, and mitigate risks of community transmission for the safety and welfare of our clients, staff, guests, contractors, and all those involved with our businesses.

Customer Service

We will continue to deliver exceptional customer service for our clients and patrons, recognising the new conditions to provide a safe experience.



If you are coming to our venue, we ask that you review the below useful information.

If you are feeling unwell, please stay home.

Please do not attend the venue if you have been unwell, have recently returned from an <u>identified</u> <u>red zone</u>, have visited an <u>exposure site</u>, or have been advised to isolate by DHHS. Please stay home if you are showing <u>symptoms of COVID-19</u>, in isolation as a result of a COVID-19 diagnosis or awaiting COVID-19 test results, or are in quarantine as a returning international traveller or have been in contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19.

Arrive early and bring your mask

We recommend arriving 30 minutes before the performance. Currently, you are required to wear a <u>face mask</u> for the duration of your visit, unless you have a lawful reason not to do so.

COVID Check-in Marshal

The venue will have a designated <u>COVID Check-In Marshal</u> who will monitor patrons checking-in and ensure they are adhering to the COVID regulations at the time of the performance.

COVIDSafe Public Events Checklist

As a Tier 3 Major Events Venue (a venue that seats less than 1,000 patrons), a <u>COVIDSafe Public</u> <u>Events Checklist</u> will be lodged before each event.

Check in with the QR codes

It is a legal requirement that all visitors must check in using the <u>Service Victoria QR codes</u>. If you are unable to use the QR codes a manual sign in sheet will be made available for you to use.

Undertake good hand and respiratory hygiene

You can play a part in maintaining a COVID safe venue. Make use of the hand sanitiser that will be available throughout the venue, and sneeze or cough into your elbow.

Practice good physical distancing

Where it is practical to do so, please ensure that you keep your distance when queuing and moving throughout the foyers. Signage throughout the theatre will help with guidance on other ways to protect your wellbeing.

In the auditorium

The auditorium will be seated in our standard layout, so you may be seated next to other patrons. Attendance is capped at 100 people per space as permitted by the government. Unused seats will be allocated to high traffic areas (per government guidance) to create buffer areas between seated patrons and those moving through the venue.

We aim to provide a COVID Safe Venue

Our comprehensive COVID Safe Plan includes control measures such as frequent and intensive cleaning before and after every performance.

Please note our Conditions of Entry

By entering the venue for a live performance, you agree to abide by our <u>Conditions of Entry for</u> <u>Theatres</u>. You are also agreeing to follow the directions of our staff and signage, and any applicable government directives.

We are closely following all Victorian Government health guidelines and will continue to update our procedures as necessary.
